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## Directions

Students will perform all of the Suzuki and Concert pieces on the Set List that are considered by their teacher to be "review" level and are able to play at close to recording tempo two weeks before dress rehearsal.

The Concert Song Levels and Links page has each song listed with the minimum review piece they should already know to be ready to learn the correlating non-Suzuki songs. For example, if they cannot play Chorus yet, they will play the harmony to Shipping to Boston.

Students will listen and figure out the appropriate Fair songs at home. Teachers will help in lessons, but students should start at home. As with Suzuki pieces, once they are at review level, they will be able to play them in group class.



- Ending: Tag played by all violin and cello




